



Round Dishcloth

crochet pattern

Skill Level

Easy

Size

The pattern creates a round dishcloth that has a diameter of approx. 7.5"

Gauge

After Round 4 following the pattern, work should measure 4"

Materials

Yarn: Approx. 50 yds of any size 4 (medium) 100% cotton yarn. I used Bernat Handicrafter Cotton Yarn. The colors used in the main photos are "Indigo" (navy blue) and "Overcast" (grey).

Crochet Hook: H/8 (5.00mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

Other Materials: yarn needle, scissors.

This pattern is written for right-handed crochet using standard US terminology. If you're more familiar with UK terms, here's my [US to UK Conversion Chart](#).

Abbreviations

ch = chain

st = stitch

sts = stitches

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

tr = triple/treble crochet

YO = yarn over

Special Stitches

Triple/Treble Crochet Stitch (tr): YO twice, insert hook into next st. YO and pull up a loop (4 loops on hook). YO, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook (3 loops on hook). YO, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook (2 loops on hook). YO, pull yarn through last 2 loops on hook.

Changing Colors

The pattern does not include directions for where to change colors because there are so many possibilities. You can make the dishcloth in one solid color or use any number of colors.

Change colors after finishing a round by placing the new color on your hook and pulling the new color through the loop of your current color. Fasten off the old color. With your new color, ch 1 and begin the next round.

Dishcloth made with two colors. I used navy blue for the Start and Rounds 1, 3, 5 & 7 and grey for Rounds 2, 4, 6, & 8.



You can also use ombre or variegated yarn to include different colors without having to weave in all the different ends! Yarn used in photo: Bernat Handicrafter Cotton Yarn, Ombres in the color "Faded Denim."

Pattern Notes

- The pattern is worked from the center out.
- Always work into the 1st st (the st attached to the chain).
- Chains never count as stitches.

Pattern Instructions

Start: Make a Magic Ring/Circle.

Round 1: 10 hdc into Magic Ring (10 sts). Pull tight. Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Round 2: Ch 1 and turn. 2 hdc into each st around (20 sts). Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Pattern Instructions (Continued)

Round 3: Ch 1 and turn. *2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st.* Repeat from * to * around (30 sts). Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Round 4: Ch 1 and turn. *2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next 2 sts.* Repeat from * to * around (40 sts). Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Measurements (optional): If size / gauge is important to you, work after Round 4 should measure 4".

Round 5: Ch 1 and turn. *2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next 3 sts.* Repeat from * to * around (50 sts). Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Round 6: Ch 1 and turn. *2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next 4 sts.* Repeat from * to * around (60 sts). Sl st into top of 1st hdc to join.

Round 7: Ch 1 and turn. *Note: anytime two sts are in parentheses, make both sts into the same st.* *(Sc, tr) in next st. Working 1 st into each of the next 5 sts: sc, tr, sc, tr, sc. (Tr, sc) in next st. Working 1 st into each of the next 5 sts: tr, sc, tr, sc, tr.* Repeat from * to * around (70 sts). Sl st into 1st sc to join.

Round 8: Ch 1 and turn. *(Sc, tr) in next st. Working 1 st into each of the next 6 sts: sc, tr, sc, tr, sc, tr.* Repeat from * to * around (80 sts). Sl st into 1st sc to join.

Fasten off and weave in all loose ends.



And now you have a new round dishcloth!
